Have you ever had a hard time getting your boat loaded and centered on the trailer, especially if you're by yourself?

Of course you have, it's a common problem for all boat owners and if it is not centered correctly it can result in expensive boat repairs.

Introducing...Cougar Boat Centering Guides!

Whether your boat trailer has carpeted bunk guide-ons or PVC guide-ons these only help to keep your boat over the trailer when loading. Because standard guide-ons are not tight to the boat hull and do flex quite a lot by design, they cannot center the boat perfectly on the trailer every time. This often results in bent trailer fenders, boat rub rail damage, scratches and gouges in the fiberglass hull, or worse, a cracked hull or broken stringers because the boat isn't properly cradled on the trailer bunks. Needless to say, these can be expensive repairs.

Problem Solved!

The new Cougar Boat Centering Guides are designed to center almost any boat on its trailer within $\frac{1}{4}$ " or less. The copyrighted and patent pending designs utilizes a fully welded 4" wide T6-6061 aircraft grade aluminum frame bolted above and below the trailer frame with a $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick white Starboard centering skid to smoothly and gently position the boat in the center of the trailer within a $\frac{1}{4}$ " or less, every time.

The Cougar Boat Centering Guides are ideal for aluminum I-beam trailer frames, but can be used on most steel and galvanized trailers as well. They are available for trailer frames from 3" to 9" in height and can be extended outward or inward up to 24" from the frame to the hull's bottom soft or hard chine. Custom centering guides are also available at no extra charge for those unique situations.

Each pair of centering guides come complete with instructions and stainless steel mounting hardware, and can typically be installed in less than 30 minutes!

MODELS & PRICING

There are 3 basic models of the centering guides.

1. “Inboard” where the trailer frame is inside of the boat hull.
2. “Outboard” where the trailer frame is outside of the boat hull.
3. “Center” where the trailer frame is directly under the bottom outside corner of the boat hull or very close to it.

There are 3 sizes of each model based on the boat’s wet weight (boat, motor, gear, batteries and fuel combined).

“STANDARD” for boats up to 3,000 lbs has $\frac{1}{4}$ ” thick aluminum frame.

“HEAVY DUTY” for boats weighing 3,001 to 7,000 lbs has a $\frac{3}{8}$ ” thick aluminum frame.

“X-HEAVY DUTY” for boats over 7,000 lbs has a $\frac{1}{2}$ ” thick aluminum frame.
